## **European consumer delegates meet upcoming Cypriot EU Presidency**

A few weeks short of the Cypriot Presidency of the European Union, a BEUC<sup>1</sup> delegation and its member the *Cyprus Consumers' Association* presented its priorities to the Minister for Commerce, Industry and Tourism Mr. Neokles Silikiotis, also responsible for consumer policy.

In light of the Cypriot Presidency's objective "to make a better Europe for citizens", BEUC urged the Minister to ensure consumer welfare is recognised as a key factor of sound policymaking and a core element of economic and social growth. The BEUC delegation highlighted the importance of the Consumer Agenda recently published by the European Commission and the proposed EU Consumer Programme 2014-2020. The fact that Cyprus will stir the Council's decisions on these two fundamental and interlinked instruments afford the Cypriot Presidency a unique opportunity to leave a lasting, consumer-friendly footprint in the EU.

Minister Silikiotis confirmed that the imminent Commission proposals on Alternative and Online Dispute Resolution would be a key priority of its Presidency. This has been welcomed by the consumer delegation who reiterated the importance of this draft law to provide – once further improved – consumers with an efficient means of accessing justice.

The meeting also addressed the EU-wide increases in energy prices, particularly concerning for Cypriot consumers and energy efficiency, the vital issue of e-commerce, access to online goods and product safety.
